Scholarships to Norway and Tertiary Institutions during 2013 and 2014

1. Entries are already open, and close on **Friday 10 February 2013**. R150 per entry. Scholarships apply.
2. All entries must be based on the work of Global Oneness Project. Inspirational sentences supplied at end of document.
3. Schools or any individual between 12 and 28 may enter as many films as they wish, but every entry needs to be sent separately.
4. Teachers, parents or other adults can assist or mentor, but the productions must be written, directed and made by amateurs between the ages of 12 and 28.
5. Entries can be in the form of a drama, documentary, music video, animation or any other creative form.
6. All entries **must** be under 5 minutes in length, titles included. No exceptions.
7. Entries can be produced with mobile phones, home cameras or more sophisticated equipment.
8. Entries can be shot in any language, but must have English subtitles for the worldwide viewers on YouTube, or other possibilities. Titles and subtitles should be clear and easy to read.
9. Every entry must clearly display its title and the original Global Oneness quote/extract at the end of the film.
10. Entries not to be uploaded on YouTube by participants. Please liaise with LivingIt..
11. Judges will give preference to entries where:
 - a) Different groups worked together, across the boundaries of race, religion, age, gender, etc.
 - b) Scripts that do not preach or force their views or inspiration on the viewer, but rather work these in subtly.
 - c) Entries that is short. (Remember, a good story can be told without words in less than 2 minutes!)

13. Every entry must send a parcel to **The Project Director, LivingIt, PO Box 4015, Idas Valley, 7609**. The parcel must include:
 - a) Three copies of the movie in DVD format

- b) One **completed** entry form (incl. full birth names and surnames)
 - c) A script in the case of a drama/short film, or a short description
 - d) Completed consent forms **from everyone who participated. Without this we cannot screen your work.**
 - e) A stamped A4 envelope addressed to yourself for feedback and certificates
 - *f) Any pictures of the process for banners, programmes and other promotion
 - *g) A short description of your experience in working across boundaries of race, religion, gender, socio-economic divides and other
14. **Entries must also be sent by e-mail to: ronel@livingit.org.za**
 15. A main contact person (parent, teacher, learner or other) **must be able to take responsibility and be easily contactable.**
 16. LivingIt accepts no responsibility for entries that get lost in the mail, for entries that for any reason cannot be uploaded on YouTube or for technical reasons cannot be played on DVD, laptop or other equipment.
 17. The Organisers have the right to cancel entries arriving without a complete entry parcel, and have the right of discretion as to what will be screened.
 18. Awards will be announced in *JIP/Die Burger*, and *Beeld* and notified by e-mail. Awarded productions will be posted on the *JIP* website.
 19. Productions will be screened at the Ubuntu Teen Film Festival at the Oude Libertas Auditorium outside Stellenbosch in June.
 20. Productions will be awarded at the Arena in Artscape, Cape Town in August 2013, screened at the prestigious Cape Winelands Film Festival in 2014 , and selected entries loaded onto YouTube for global distribution.
